(MULBARTON) (EMERGENCY NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2020
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to repairs to a burst water main the use by vehicles of the C179 East Carleton Road from its junction with B1113 Norwich Road for a distance of 82m north westwards in the PARISH OF MULBARTON will be temporarily prohibited from 14th September 2020 to 18th September 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 5 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.


Alternative route is via: East Carleton Road, Scotts Hill, Rectory Road, Catbridge Lane, Norwich Road (Mulbarton/ East Carleton).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
